

## ORDER

New Delhi, the 14<sup>th</sup> January, 2002

S.O.57[E) – In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with sub-section (1) of section 16 of the Jute Packaging Materials (Compulsory Use in Packing Commodities) Act, 1987 (10 of 1987), the Central Government hereby, makes the following amendments in the Order of the Ministry of Textiles published in Gazette of India, Part-II, section 3, sub-section (ii) vide S.O. 853 (E) dated 1<sup>st</sup> September 2001, namely: -

In the said notification, after paragraph 2, the following paragraph shall be inserted, namely: -

“2A. In the case of sugar packed for export, but which could not be exported, a separate mechanism will be worked out for exempting such sale from the purview of the Order. Ministry of Textiles is authorized to issue such relaxation Orders based on an assessment and request by Department of Food and Public Distribution.”

2. This notification shall take affect from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.
