### Monthly Summary to the Cabinet for the Month of June, 2022

1. Important policy : NIL

2. Important Achievements:

- I. All India arrival of seed cotton was around 16.12 lakh bales. Cumulative arrival of cotton this cotton season from October 2021 to June 2022 has been 300.67 lakh bales. This is approx. 12% less as compared to corresponding period of last year. Data line for duty free import of raw cotton has been extended upto 31.10.2022. Price of raw cotton in domestic market has started softening up. It is expected that crop coverage under cotton this year would be higher by about 10% as farmers got very good price in the cotton year 2021-22. Since the price of cotton in the market is ruling above MSP, Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) has not procured cotton under MSP operations during June, 2022.
- II. In order to promote Handlooms in domestic and overseas market, Handloom Export Promotion Council organized two International Events – (i) Heimtxtil, Frankfurt, Germany and (ii) Sari Festival in Oslo, Norway, during in the month of June, 2022.

Under the **Weavers' Mudra Scheme**, in June 2022, 192 number of MUDRA Loans were sanctioned.

- III. Under Production **Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme**, 64 applicants were selected and letters of approval were sent to 32 selected participants in June, 2022. Further, a meeting under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Textiles) was held on 10.06.2022 for reviewing the PLI Scheme for Textiles and discussing way forward for Round II of PLI. A meeting was also held under the chairmanship of Secretary (Textiles) to discuss the HS Codes of Technical Textiles under PLI Scheme.
- IV. 5<sup>th</sup> National Conclave for Standards in Technical Textiles with the theme: 'Building Standards for India@2047' was organised by FICCI in collaboration with M/o Textiles, on 10.06.2022, wherein. Secretary (Textiles) delivered the inaugural address.

**VI. “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign under “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” (AKAM):**

Government of India has taken initiative “Har Ghar Tiranga” campaign under “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” (AKAM). For a successful and participatory programme, it is envisaged that more than 10 Crore Indian household covering a significant portion of India's population, will hoist the flag during the ‘Independence Week’ in August 2022. Ministry of Textiles has been given the target to get manufactured about 6 Crore National Flags. In this regard, a Group of Ministers meeting was held on 02.06.2022 to review the status of the campaign. Subsequently, letters were sent to all the manufacturers on 08.06.2022 and 22.06.2022 asking the details of the manufacturers of the flags Secretary (Textiles) held a meeting on 29.06.2022 with the Senior Officials and the manufacturers.

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
